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## In the Construction Zone Materials Prep

For each *Explore It* theme, we'll let you know what materials are needed for each module (each day) of the theme, and we'll also let you know if there's materials prep you can do before the themed week kicks off. Ideally, it's great to do this prep together as a family!

Note that for nearly every activity, if you're missing a material or two, you'll likely be fine! These activities are designed to be flexible.

- We recommend that all Explorers (age 7-10) use an Explorer Notebook across the *Explore It* experience. If you can, get one they can decorate themselves!
- In Module 12, we will make virtual 3D designs using a program called <u>TinkerCAD</u>. You will need a computer, laptop, or tablet, as well as an Internet Browser (Firefox, Chrome, etc.) This is a free program, but it requires that you set up an account. You may want to set up the account before Module 12. There will be a full tutorial video available in the module to follow.

### Module 10 (Monday, July 27)

Activities: Measuring Warm-Up, Straw Structures, Design Your Own Clubhouse

- 1 Small ball (like a tennis ball)
- 1 Weight (books, notebooks, or something similar)
