Module 2, Warm-Up



Prompt:


Use sticks, leaves, rocks, and other things from nature to play tic tac toe!

Materials:

- 4 sticks, small rocks, or something to use for the board (you could also just draw a tic tac toe board with pencil or crayon on paper)
- 5 similar rocks, leaves, or something from nature to use for one player
- 5 similar (but different from the other 5!) rocks, leaves, or something from nature to use for the second player

Instructions:

- 1. Take a walk outside to collect the materials you need for the game. You can use objects that you collected on a walk or find items around the house.
- 2. Ask someone to play the game with you. Set up your game board.



- 3. Decide which player will use which set of similar objects to play.
- 4. Play tic tac toe!
 - a. The goal of tic tac toe is to get three objects in a row (horizontally, vertically, or diagonally). To play, one person will put one of their objects in one of the squares. Then the next person places one of their objects in a different square. Continue this until someone gets three in a row!
