Module 4, Warm-Up



Prompt:

Use your imagination to make a poem that rhymes!

Materials:

- Paper
- Pencil or pen
- Markers, crayons, or colored pencils
- *Optional: Explorer Notebook*

Instructions:

1. Think of a word you like, a word that you think is silly, or a word that is really important to you.
2. Come up with at least 5 words that rhyme with your word.
3. Use the words to make your own poem that rhymes.
4. Write your poem and add some drawings to it! Maybe even add some color to your drawings!

For explorers using an Explorer Notebook:

1. Pick your word and make a list of words that rhyme with it.
2. Write your poem. Draw some pictures to go with your poem.

Check out the last page for a page design idea. You can use this or set up your page however you want!

Extensions:

The following are optional steps you can take if you want to extend this adventure:

1. Make a frame for your poem.
2. Ask someone else to come up with a word and create a poem for them.
3. Go to the "In Your Imagination" topic on Flipgrid and share your creation!
